



House Teams

At Funtington, each child across the school belongs to one of four houses. The house team names were chosen by the children using a democratic voting system:

Mario
Yoshi
Luigi
Toad

Through the House system we aim to encourage competition, team work and student mentorship. We use the house team system to encourage all children to follow our Funtington Footprints.

House points will be awarded for the following things:

- Link with the Reading rockets – house point given each time they move their rocket to the top of the chart.
- Completion of grid homework tasks
- Each class teacher and Teaching Assistant has discretion to award house points for specific things e.g. spelling/ tables tests results, exceptional effort, following Funtington Footprints etc.

Each week all of the house points are added up and the winning team are awarded extra playtime. The totals are displayed in the hall.

On Sports Day each child will be competing for their School House to win the Sports Shield.

Every half term the school organises a house team activity linked to a different curriculum area. The children work together to ensure that everyone participates, enjoys and achieves. Recent house team activities have included a science activity for Mother's Day, a mindfulness activity to promote children's wellbeing, an ERIC activity for World Book Day and an RE nativity activity for Christmas.
